Tuesday, July 12, 2016

- I. The meeting was called to order by Terry Tanner at 11:03 a.m. at Shoney's Restaurant in Jasper Indiana.
- II. Introductions were made by Terry Tanner, Janet Schnell, Audrey Fleck, Ashlee Murphy, Mary Curtis, Brett Hurm, Nancy Eckerle, Josh Gunselman, Megan Durlauf, Jennifer Lampert, Tim Lampert, and Josh Cary.
- III. Mary Curtis made a correction to May minutes to read she attends Drug Court graduations. A motion to approve the June minutes presented by Jennifer Lampert and Janet Schnell was made by Nancy, seconded by Josh, and all members in attendance approved.
- IV. Terry gave treasurer's report:
  - A. Prevention/Education: \$8,594.93
  - B. Treatment/Intervention: \$8,594.93
  - C. Criminal Justice Services: \$8,594.93
  - D. Discretionary: \$4,386.04
  - E. User Fees Collected in June, 2016: \$2,353.28 with total for 2016: \$15,506.28A motion to approve the treasurer's report was made by Mary, seconded by Chad, and all members in attendance approved.
- V. Coordinator's report was given by Janet. She spent 22.25 hours in June working with grantees on future grants. Janet brought letter from Indiana Criminal Justice Institute Executive Director, David R. Murtaugh, she will email to SAC members. Information on inpatient detoxification policy to be implemented August 1, 2016 regarding evidenced-based practice approved was shared by ICJI. A training will take place on August 5 in Lawrenceburg for LCC Coordinators, Law Enforcement, EMS and Substance Abuse Treatment Providers. Janet plans to attend and bring back information for Dubois County. She will email the information to SAC members. As a reminder agencies can begin applying for grants by visiting <http://www.duboiscountysubstanceabuse.org/>, clicking on Grant Application, and opening Grant Application 2015-2016-2017. Complete the application and submit to Janet for approval for the September meeting. The Comprehensive Plan was approved in May. She is waiting to hear back from ICJI on By laws submitted in May. SAC will be sponsoring a substance abuse and mental health disorder training on August 15 at VUJC from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. Presenting is provided by Brentwood Meadows geared towards CASA workers.
- VI. Representatives' reports were given by:
  - A. Chad Blessinger, Nancy Eckerle, and Josh A. Gunlseman nothing to report.
  - B. Tim Lampert reported 96 inmates with 63 males and 30 females. 11 incarcerated for alcohol and 12 for drug offences.

- C. Jennifer Lampert reported from April to June there are 600 people on probation. 60% have drug or alcohol offenses. 32 were revoked for drug or alcohol offenses.
  - D. Megan Durlauf reported TANF grant ended and passed around workbooks currently being used in Community Corrections.
  - E. Brett V. Hurm reported Southern Hills is at near capacity for MATRIX and Drug & Alcohol groups. There is a wait list of 1 ½ months. Intakes on Friday are going well with 4 to 5 clients requesting services.
- VII. Progress Reports
- A. Forest Park Jr./Sr. High School – Audrey Fleck – Forest Park Drug Testing Program granted \$1,000.00. Audrey gave a reported 133 students were tested with positive results (4) Amphetamines, (2) Cannabinoids, (3) Cotinine, and (2) diluted specimen.
  - B. Northeast Dubois Post Prom – DeAnn Meyer – did not show for report. Janet will contact DeAnn and Tammy. Before another grant can be submitted an oral and written report must be provided.
